## **PAYMENT DETAILS**

The Registration Service Fee for Tbilisi State Medical University (TSMU) is \$200 USD Dollars (Non-refundable). The \$200 Payment covers translation and notarization of your documents for submission to Admission Board for review. Afterwards, the student will be told when he/she will have a video interview with the University.

If the student passes the interview, he/she will receive a placement letter from Tbilisi State Medical University within 7 work days. Then, the student will be required to pay additional \$300 fee for his/her documents to be submitted for recognition to National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement.

Admission Office can make provisions for Immigration support; Airport pick-up, Accommodation reservation, and residence permit documentation services to the applicant for a reasonable fee of \$400. If you'd like Admission Office to provide the above mentioned services for you, kindly transfer an additional \$400 to the designated TBC Bank account. (You can request for these services later too)
